

# Gaining your S/NVQ in timber frame erection and CSCS blue skilled worker card

## Site carpenters only (pathway 4)

Pathway 4 is aimed at existing workers who already have an NVQ in Site Carpentry and need to complete two units to gain the NVQ in Timber Frame Erection. The only condition is that you must have the unit certificate from your NVQ in Site Carpentry so that we can map the units straight in to the NVQ in Timber Frame Erection (called Accreditation for Prior Learning or APL for short).

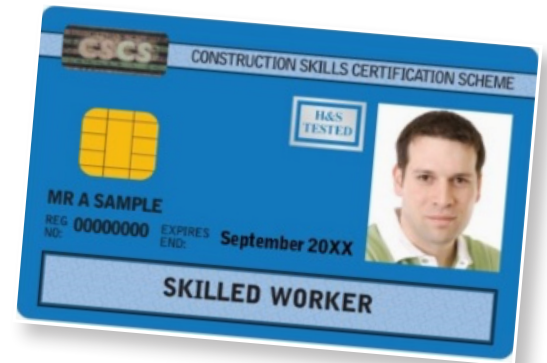
On completion, the NVQ will be added to your existing CSCS card as evidence of competency in timber frame erection.

To register on the NVQ follow the process outlined on the STA website

>> **TRAINING tab**

>> **Route to S/NVQ & Skilled Worker CSCS Card**

Here you will find all the information relating to getting signed up on the NVQ. Follow the process laid out on the web page:



### Route to S/NVQ & skilled worker CSCS card



Complete the initial contact form and submit to the training provider (Coleg Sir Gâr)



You will be contacted within five working days. An enrolment form will be attached for you to complete. Scan/photograph and send back to [dave.howells@colegsirgar.ac.uk](mailto:dave.howells@colegsirgar.ac.uk)



An invoice will be raised for the payee, whether an individual or your company is paying for the qualification. Once the payment has cleared, you will be registered for the NVQ and your e-Portfolio set up.



A login is automatically emailed to you once the e-Portfolio is set up and an assessor will contact you to undertake the initial visit.



If your employer is the payee, they will have access to your e-Portfolio to provide local support and monitor your progress.



You will then work with your assessor to complete the qualification.



Once completed and signed off by the assessor and internal quality assurer, we will email you with an e-Certificate within 24 hours\* to upgrade to the blue skilled workers card.

The paper certificates normally take up to six weeks from the awarding body, hence why e-Certificate are sent out to avoid delays.

**NOTE:** If your current CSCS card is no longer valid (i.e. green labourers card), we will issue you, on request, evidence of your registration to send to CSCS, enabling you to gain a temporary red card (assuming you have already completed the Operatives H&S Test).



As learners are across the UK and Ireland, Coleg Sir Gâr uses an e-Portfolio for learners to work through the NVQ (depending on experience, this can be a couple of months) supported by an experienced assessor from the sector.

Please note that learners will communicate through the ePortfolio messaging system, email, Skype, Facetime and an observation on site when good progress is being made.
